Conditions: Applicant is responsible for obtaining a qualified plumber to make the water tap connection and pay for all costs associated with said tap and all costs associated with laying service from the main to the applicant's connection point, including any required meter pits. The Town will be responsible for providing a 1-inch meter and remote reading device for applicant's installation. The property owner will be responsible for all other parts associated with the tap connection. A curb stop is required by the town to be placed between the town provided meter and the structure being connected to at the expense of the property owner. Town Code, Section Seven, Chapter One, must be strictly followed for all installations. Property owner hereby agrees that upon connection to the system, he/she will pay the usual and customary fee commencing at the time of said connection.

Property owner assumes all responsibility for utility billing and tap fees. If responsibility is assigned to a renter, all unpaid bills at time of departure will be re-assigned to the property owner. If connection is abandoned, regular monthly fees will be assessed unless owner asks for a waiver from the Town Council. Waiver Condition: All payments which have been suspended must be paid before another connection to this meter can be made. If the amount of the suspended bill is more than a tap fee, the bill may be paid by paying a new tap fee or the suspended amount, whichever is less. The owner/s agree to comply with the ordinances of the Town of LaGrange pertaining to the said system and its operation, and agree that this document shall constitute a covenant running with the property.
