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Minutes from August Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on August 13th 2026 at 7:00pm. Present were Mayor, Kirk Haas; Councilmembers, John Goold, Jenny Pragnell, Tracy May and Mike Huseby. Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell and Clerk/Treasurer, Cathy Stoddard were also present.

Visitors attending were: Julia Belopotosky from Midwest Assistance Program, Ryan Dickey from Torrington Telegram, CJ from Sunrise Engineering, Renee Winfrey, Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Tammy DiRienzo, Linnea Dix and Mark Marshall.

Mayor Haas called the meeting to order at 7:04pm. John moved to approve the minutes as read. Jenny seconded, motion carried.

Julia Belopotosky of Midwest Assistance Program came to discuss the rate analysis performed for the Town of LaGrange water and sewer infrastructure.

Mayor Haas asked for public discussion. After brief discussion, Mayor Haas asked for old business. Cathy and Tracy gave updates on current grant applications.

Mayor Haas asked for new business. Mike moved to approve Resolution #3-26 FY Budget Amendment Resolution. John seconded, motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were discussed. John moved to approve a water permit for lot 5, block 5 Miskimins Addition and a sewer permit for lot 6 block 5 Miskimins Addition. Jenny seconded, motion carried. Mike moved to approve the bills, John seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:05pm.
